#### **Rifle Competition**

After a break of 8 years, .22 caliber rifle competition has returned to SCCSFA thanks to the efforts of Al Wells. On Saturday, July 22nd, the match was held at the 50 yard range. There were 2 classes: iron sights and modified (scope). Three rounds were shot; two rounds from the bench and one round free hand, standing. The styles of the rifles were varied – running the spectrum from full competition to minimalist survival to AR15. There were 9 competitors.

1st place in iron sight was won by Dave Stevens, who also had over all high score. 1st place in modified was Kristian Quiroz.

#### **Announcements**

At the September General Meeting, the Executive Board will be requesting approval for \$5,000 to make improvements to the lake parking area. The improvements will allow members to drive to the lake rather than walking the hill.

A new lobby guard system was installed in the lobby for signing in and out of the club. Please pay attention as to where you card must be held to allow scanning. It is different from the previous unit. See picture to the right.

- 1. Always sign in and out using your membership card at the Lobby Guard Station.
- 2. Check the electronic bulletin board when singing-in for the correct shooting times and other announcements.
- 3. Turn off the lights in the clubhouse when leaving.
- 4. In-Bound traffic always has the right of way.
- 5. Maintain the 10 mph Driveway Speed limit.

It's a PA Fish & Boat Commission violation to throw trash or debris along waterway or adjacent lands. This includes fishing line. Throwing away fishing line around the lake has become a major problem. It is causing damage to the mower, increasing cost for repair and labor. Please be courteous, remove your trash.
