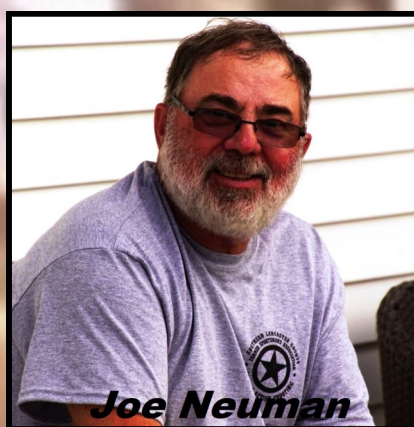

Dr. Edward I. Weitzman



We are sorrowed to announce long time SCCS&FA member, Dr. Edward I. Weitzman of Avondale, PA passed away on November 19, 2021 at the age of 80.

“Doc” Weitzman was a family medicine doctor in Avondale, getting his medical degree from the University of Osteopathic Medical Health Science.

Doc was a member of the SCCS&FA for over 25 years and Chairman of the Full Auto Committee. He served on the SCCS&FA Board of Directors for many years and ran for President of the organization.

He was an avid collector of machine guns and participated regularly in the SCCS&FA Field Day where he set up various machine guns and Gatlin guns to let youngsters fire them. He was also a Flight Surgeon and a pilot of both small aircraft and helicopters.

He was a member of the Target Shooting Solutions and the Brandywine Polo Club.

Doc is survived by his longtime partner, Phyllis Osborne, his daughters Debbie Weitzman and Sharon Fraley [Keith], 2 sisters, 3 step-sons, 2 nephews and 6 grandchildren.

2. All the members and guests taking the time to attend the event which was so wonderfully planned and executed for their enjoyment.

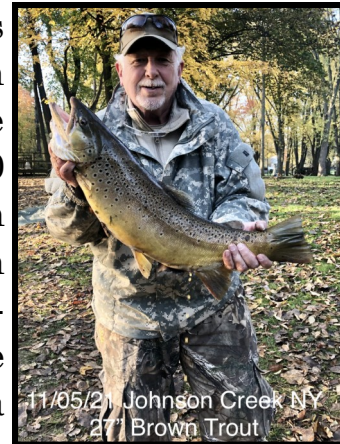
Member's Corner by John Primus, Newsletter
