

**Change to Target Rules:** The following changes were approved effective 10/1/10, questions on this to Warren Goodwin, Club Safety Officer at [safety@sccsfa.org](mailto:safety@sccsfa.org)

**Steel Targets: .22 Cal rim fire lead bullets only (no magnum)** all targets must be designed for .22 caliber and be at least 3/16" thick. Steel targets must be at least 25 yards from the shooting position and mounted within 4 feet of the front of the target backer. Height can be 3-5 feet off the ground. Eye protection must be worn by all present.

**Self-healing Rubber targets:** Must be at least 10 yards from the shooting position, within 4 feet of the front of the target backer and 3-5 feet off the ground.

**Clay Pigeons:** Must be mounted within 4 feet of the target backer or affixed to the target backer in the same area used by paper targets (3-5 feet off the ground). Broken pigeons must be removed from the range.
