Committee News

Archery

A reminder of the rules and regulations for hunting the SCCS&FA outdoor archery range:

- Members Only (No guests)
- 2 Hunters per day
- Cost: \$20 per day per hunter
- All Pennsylvania Game Laws and SCCS&FA club rules must be followed
- Must sign in and out at the club house
- Display hunting warning sign on dash while hunting. Pick up sign from back of sign-in book
- Hunting on SCCS&FA property is archery (bow & crossbow) only
- Hunters under 18 must be accompanied by an adult with one shared bow/crossbow
- No permanent stands may be erected
- Temporary stands may be used and must be labeled with owner's name and membership number at all times
- Stands must be taken down within one week of the season's end
- Safety harness must be used when in stands
- Please note on sign-in book harvested deer sex and number of points (if buck)

Junior

Launching a new season of the Junior Marksmanship Program.



Come out on Sunday afternoons (2pm-4pm) to develop skills to improve your marksmanship. All classes are led by qualified instructors and coaches. Achieve rewards and recognition throughout the program and attend competitive events to demonstrate proficiency.

Rifle Marksman Program (RMP) Details

The program is open to SCCSFA Members and invited guests and runs Mid-March to Mid-October (depending on weather).

Ages:

- Juniors are 12 to 17
- Adults are 18 and older
- Anyone under 12 will be considered on a case by case basis.

Cost:

- Free for Juniors (specifically ammo, awards, and the club has some rifles that can be used)
- Adults are responsible for their own ammo and costs of awards and patches. There are a few club rifles that can be used.

Time:

 The RMP will start at 2 pm on each Sunday and end promptly at 4 pm due to the end of allowed shooting time. There are two tracks within the Winchester/NRA Rifle Marksman Program that we will participate in. You may choose either Track. The details for each can be found on the NRA website.

- 4-Position Qualification
 Note: Only aperture and iron sights are allowed, not telescopic
- NEW <u>Hunter Marksman</u> Qualification
 NOTE: This program does allow for Telescopic,
 Aperture, or Iron Sights.
