Overall this will help make it much easier for members to pick up their brass (as is required) and gives the sheds a tidy appearance.




This is the first step in the range improvement program. Next comes lighting.


Membership

Our current active membership stands at 1,381 representing 89% of the members we have on file. A further 72 (4.6%) have not renewed, 51 (3.3%) are in the pipeline to join as new members and 47 (3%) are not eligible to renew because their NRA membership does not meet the requirement to run through the full membership year.
