Course: NRA Basics of Rifle Shooting

Course Overview:

The NRA Basics of Rifle Shooting is a course consisting of interactive learning, demonstration, and live fire exercises conducted at a range under the guidance and supervision of an NRA-Certified Instructor.

Location:

SCCS&FA, 720 Sportsman's Lane, Kennett Square, PA 19348 Clubhouse Classroom on 6/3/2023 8 AM to 4 PM (No Ammo Allowed in Classroom) Live Fire on 6/4/2023 75 yd range Noon to 4 PM

Description:

This eight-hour course is conducted in a classroom (six hours) and live fire exercises (two hours). Students will learn gun safety rules, proper operation of lever, bolt and semi-automatic firearms, ammunition knowledge/selection, selecting and storing a firearm, the fundamentals of shooting, and inspection and maintenance. Each student will receive a Student Study Guide and a Course Evaluation form.

During the live fire exercises, an NRA-Certified Instructor will validate comprehension and application of gun safety rules, range protocol, proper handling, loading and unloading procedures, application of shooting fundamentals.

Certification Requirements:

Students need a 90% or better score to pass the written exam and demonstrate learning during live fire

How to Register:

Please first reach out to the SCCS&FA education committee. After their approval, students will need to register by 5/31/2023 on the NRA Site to be fully enrolled and receive credit for the course. This private course is reserved for SCCS&FA families participating in the Junior or Adult Marksmanship Programs. *Please do not forward the link*. PDR LLC reserves the right to unenroll any student.

What Students Should Bring:

- A positive and teachable attitude
- Saturday- lunch, drinks (No Alcohol) and snacks
 - Do NOT bring your firearms or ammunition on Saturday.
- Sunday- Rifle in safe working order*, Minimum 150 rounds of factory ammunition*, and drinks (No Alcohol)
 - Students under 18 will have access to club rifles and ammunition.

*Ammunition and rifles are <u>not</u> included in the cost of the course and are the responsibility of the student. Arrangements can be made if you do not own a suitable firearm. Do not bring hand-loaded (reloaded) ammunition.

What to wear on the Range:

Clothing for movement, long pants, closed-toe shoes, long sleeve shirt and baseball hat, eye, ear protection
