Field Day 2023 and 75th Anniversary Celebration

Saturday, October 28th, 10 am to 3 pm

- The Trap Committee has completed the installation of a manual trap in the newly renovated Trap Shed. The trap is preset to release clays in an approved shot area. Members are not permitted to alter the settings. The new trap thrower has the capability to throw single or double clays.
- The Executive Committee has approved an updated SCCSFA Handbook. It is posted on the website and can be downloaded to view and print. This latest version clarifies some of the rules and has new sections added.
- The most notable handbook section for your attention pertains to Trap shooting and the requirement to obtain a Special

Use Permit to use your privately owned trap thrower.

- The Jr. Rifle Program is expanding to include a high-power discipline. At the October General meeting, they will ask the membership to approve a purchase of needed equipment and ammo for a cost not to exceed \$3,000.
- Also at the October meeting, the Facilities committee will seek approval for a proposal to line the driveway and a section between the outdoor archery range and trap field with 100, five-foot, Green Giant Arborvitae. The cost to purchase, deliver, plant, and fertilize is \$7,000.
- The new pole building is almost complete. It will serve all the range committees to house equipment and targets. As well as the range maintenance equipment and supplies.
