Remember anyone 16 and older needs a fishing license and trout stamp per state regulations. Please note, the deadline to renew membership has already passed and you cannot renew at this time.

The lake will be stocked on April 1st at noon. There will be one truck this year and we would ideally like to have 20 volunteers to help move all the fish into the lake.
